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Specifications of SCBA Air Compressor & Filling Station Bid

Price: Bid price shall include all necessary production costs including shipment, installation and tax. No incidental costs for visits to the Malvern Fire Company will be reimbursed outside the scope of this bid.

Standard: All equipment shall meet or exceed the requirements of NFPA 1901, Standard on Automotive Fire Apparatus 2009 Edition.

Quality Assurance Program: Bidder must demonstrate that manufacturer has a quality assurance program in place.

Technical Specifications:

<u>Compressor Fill Capability:</u> The compressor should be capable of no less than 6.0 CFM and be capable of outputting no less than 4500 PSI.

Compressor Horsepower: The compressor should have no less than a 5.0 HP motor.

<u>Filling Station Requirements:</u> Filling station should be capable of holding and filling two sixty minute SCBA cylinders. Filling station should also include adequate air storage cylinders.

<u>Total Dimensions</u>: Total dimensions for all equipment should not exceed 74" Tall, 84" Wide and 41" Deep.

Inspection: All equipment shall be inspected upon delivery to ensure all standards and bid specifications have been met. The equipment will be powered on and operated as intended.

Training: Bidder will provide Malvern Fire Company members with basic training in safe operation of the equipment described herein.

Timeline: Upon bid award, bidder must deliver and install all equipment and pass inspection as noted above prior to March 31, 2015.

Payment: Payment will be issued via a single check within 30 days of the equipment passing inspection. Should any equipment fail inspection, the bidder will be required to address any issues prior to payment.
